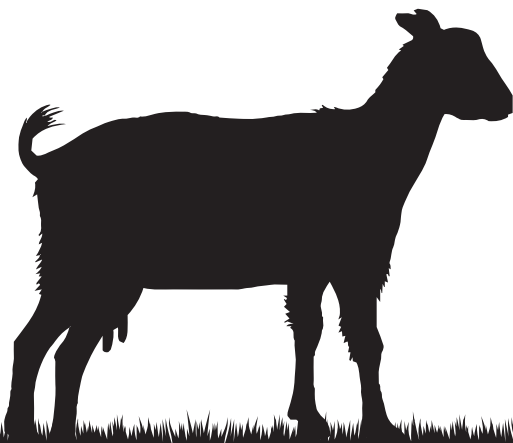

### DAIRY GOAT RULES

1. Does in milk must not be milked out before they are judged, except for the second half of best udder class.
2. The practice of gluing of teats, in any form, or any foreign substances in the udder is considered an act of malpractice and will result in disqualification.
3. Does will not be penalised if it is necessary to ease their udders before judging, owing to their udders being overstocked.
4. Does may not be stripped out in the ring.
5. The standard RAS bylaws for the exhibition of dairy goats shall apply.
6. Judges shall not judge any animals owned by them or their immediate family including defacto relationships. This excludes leased animals.
7. Reserve Championship. The second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected, is to parade with the other prize winners for Reserve Champion.
8. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
9. PROTEST: Any protest must be made in writing, signed by the person making the complaint and delivered to the Secretary accompanied by \$200 cash which will be refunded should the protest be upheld.

## **PRIZEMONEY**

1st \$8, 2nd \$6, 3rd \$4. (GST incl) or product, unless otherwise stated.

Prize money will be paid by direct banking within four weeks (28<sup>th</sup> November 2022). If you have not received your prize money by this date, please notify the office immediately. Notification must be made no later than 8<sup>th</sup> December 2022. Notification after this date will not be considered.

If promised sponsorship is not forthcoming the Association cannot be held liable. All entry fees and prize money are GST inclusive.

ANY EXHIBITOR WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES, MAY FORFEIT THEIR PRIZE MONEY.

## PUBLICATION OF EXHIBITOR'S NAME

Entry in the Show entitles the host association to publish an Exhibitors name/photo(s) of an entrant and distribute with exhibitor lists and in result reports.

## YELLOW CARD AND FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCES

The following text will appear on every affiliated A&P Show/Event Schedule.

- i. **Yellow Card-** This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/ Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website – [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz).
- ii. **Forbidden Substance** - The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Forbidden Substances apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person's responsible risk.
- iii. **Forbidden Substance** - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of any animal by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.
- iv. **Arrears** – No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other show/event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated show/event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.
- v. **Summary of RAS Resolution Process** – the full process can be found on the RAS website [www.ras.org.nz](http://www.ras.org.nz). The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.

## LEGAL LIABILITY/ SUPERVISION & CONTROL OF ANIMAL/S:

The Association's insurance policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Welfare Act 1999 which requires people to take all reasonable steps to ensure that the physical, health and behavioural needs of your animals are met in accordance with the good practice and scientific knowledge. Each species-specific code can be found at [www.mpi.govt.nz/welfarecodes](http://www.mpi.govt.nz/welfarecodes). Exhibitors must comply with the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, for further information please visit [www.worksafe.govt.nz/laws-and-regulations/acts/hswa/](http://www.worksafe.govt.nz/laws-and-regulations/acts/hswa/). No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Chief Steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible for an Exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.

## TEST AND TAG:

Due to 2016 H&S Regulations and because Claudelands is a business property, all electrical leads and electrical appliances brought on to the property must have a current Test N Tag Electrical Certificate. Any lead or appliance not compliant will need to be tested and certified on site at the owner's cost.

## COVID-19

If you are suffering from any signs or symptoms associated with Covid-19 prior to the show, please DO NOT attend and contact the Supervisor to advise you are unable to attend.

If any competitor presents with sign and symptoms associated with COVID-19, they are required to isolate from the event, get tested and follow all Ministry of Health Guidelines. Entry fees will be refunded should the Show have to be cancelled due to Covid-19

*Two daughters in milk of the same sire, but different dams. Names of the sire and dams to be given on the entry form.*

Class 5010 HERD REGISTER TYPE & PRODUCTION.

*Rules as per RAS regulations.*

Class 5011 ASSOCIATED RECORDS TYPE & PRODUCTION.

*Rules as per RAS regulations.*

Class 5012 HERD REGISTER BEST UDDER.

*Open to all does that have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points to be awarded for full and empty udder to be totalled to determine prize winners. (Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for the second part).*

Also the handling and health of the adult goat. Doe does not have to belong to the exhibitor.*
