Registration confirmation from 9am

Judging Commences at 10am – No ribbons placed or given till 10.20am

Event 1: Most Obvious Pet (MOP)

1.1 Champion/Reserve Champion Most Obvious Pet (Held in Champion ring)

Event 2: Leading

2.1 Champion/Reserve Champion Leading (Held in Champion ring)

Event 3: Athol McLachlan Cup (Held in Champion ring)

Contested between Champion MOP and Champion Leading only
(MOP and Leading Champions need to re-run in both events)

Group of Three are assembling while Athol McLachlan Cup is being contested

Event 4: Group of Three

After group of three, time is allotted for students to prepare their animal for rearing and to have a rest/food break (10-15 minutes)

In both Early and Late Rearing, all lambs to stay in their respected rings so there will be both Early and Late events in each ring

Event 5: Rearing Early

5.1 Champion/Reserve Champion Early (Held in Champion ring)

Event 6: Rearing Late

6.1 Champion/Reserve Champion Late (Held in Champion ring)

Event 7: Champion/Reserve Champion Rearing Overall (Held in Champion ring)

Champions – Early & Late (Combined)

In all Championship events “The 2nd placed contestant to the Champion” will be judged to obtain weather it is better than the 2nd placed contestant in the Champion ring.

In ‘**Overall Rearing Champion**’ this will be the Reserve Champion to the Champion

Lamb Feeding

There is to be no bottle feeding (milk or water) from the arrival at the A & P Show Grounds till after the **Group of Three event**.

If observed feeding before this time the Head Steward may warn the contestant or stand the contestant down from the next event or from all events.
