COMPETITOR INFORMATION:

- Run under the rules of the NZ Sheep Dog Trials Association.
- Sheep will be worked before the trial and should be quiet and manageable.
- Dogs will run in catalogue order; however, the Committee reserves the right to vary the order of running.
- The Judge will call off any dog causing distress to sheep.
- An information sheet will be sent out with the draw closer to the show.
- Prize money may be cash and / or product.
- Enter dogs in preferred order.
- Should entries exceed the number that can be accommodated, selection will be made from those with multiple entries and last to enter.

LEGAL LIABILITY/ SUPERVISION & CONTROL OF ANIMAL/S:

- The Association's insurance policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors.
- Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.
- Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate Animal Welfare Act 1999 which requires people to take all reasonable steps to ensure that the physical, health and behavioural needs of your animals are met in accordance with the good practice and scientific knowledge.

- No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission from the Chief Steward of that ring.
- Only persons directly responsible for an Exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.
